Guardian Endpoint Protection combines centrally managed endpoint security with Damocles-managed operating-system and supported third-party application patching across the agreed covered device scope.

Included managed service

- Endpoint security agent onboarding and protection policy
- Device protection and health visibility
- Vulnerability and available-patch context
- Managed operating-system patch deployment
- Managed supported third-party application patching
- Maintenance-window and restart coordination
- Patch failure, exception and unsupported-software follow-up
- Guardian remediation actions, evidence and reporting

Participant, business and provider views

- Participants see only their linked devices, protection state and relevant remediation guidance.
- Business customers receive estate-level protection, vulnerability, patch and remediation posture.
- Providers operate their own and authorised customer estates through scoped entitlements, installer control, device mapping and reporting.

Supported scope

Covered endpoints, operating systems, supported applications, patch cadence, maintenance windows, exclusions, restart handling and service responsibilities are confirmed in the package schedule. Major upgrades, unsupported or end-of-life software, emergency change and engineering remediation may require separate approval.
